

# 4.17 Media age filter

If you would like to only check recent media articles in case searches, a setting is now added to Pascal to set a time range you would like to search in media for possible hits on your cases.

How to change this setting:

- 1 Go to the Settings page
- 2 Select the Policies tab
- 3 Scroll down to the Filtering section in the page
- 4 At the bottom of this section, the dropdown Media age filter can be used to only search on recent media articles. The filter has the options from: only consider the last year to only consider the last 10 years and every year in between.
- 5 After changing this setting, select the Save button to save the changes you have made.
