

# 6.0 Monitoring frequencies

We have added more flexibility to the way you can monitor for new results in Pascal. From the Pascal 6.0 update, you can change monitoring frequencies per source. This can be changed as a default setting, but can also be changed in an individual case as well.

To change your monitoring frequency within your Pascal environment navigate to the **Screening Settings** and update the **Monitoring frequency** in the **Policies** page. After changes have been made, save the changes by pressing the **Save** button.


